Old Business


OS-1 passed with the modifications of "minimum 60" clearance from pole and 6'-5' clearance from and structures"; Derrick made the motion Jim seconded. OS-1A passed with modifications to remove the word "optional" and add a note stating "6-5' clearance from any structures" with Derrick making the motion and Shawn seconding. OS-2 passed with no modifications with a motion from Jim and a second from Derrick. OS-2A passed with no modifications with a motion from Derrick and a second from Jim. OS-3 passed with the modification of changing 12" max to minimum and adding a diagram that shows 12' minimum clearance under fascia, Derrick made the motion and Jim seconded the motion. OS-5, OS-7, OS-8 and OS-9 passed with no modifications and Derrick making the motion and Jim seconding the motion. OS-6 passed with the modification of adding a 12" minimum drip loop with Derrick making the motion and Jim seconding the motion.

New Business

Roger read the Open Meetings Act Resolution and Derrick moved to approve it and Jim seconded the motion. The motion passed with no objection.

Jim made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Derrick seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at 2:14 p.m.
