ADDENDUM ONE

Notice to Bidders: The above referenced bid is hereby amended as follows:

Questions and Answers:

Question 1: Will you consider extending the completion date from December 20, 2013 to a later date.

Answer 1: No, the using department wants the work completed by December 20, 2013.

Question 2: I understand this transmission line is owned by another party, do you have access to the GIS data or .shp files so we can map this line segment?

Answer 2: According to the FEUS GIS Tech, yes - we do have GPS data and a shape file of the line.

Question 3: Our files show a digitized map of what we believe to be the 69kV line in question and match the PDF map provided in the bid. Are you able to confirm with the owner that we are looking at the line to be inspected?

Answer 3: Yes, the information you have is correct, but incomplete. The rest of the line effectively closes the triangle, making a loop fed transmission line. Your files are just approximations and only contain about 75% of the line.

Question 4: Are all of the power poles accessible by a four wheel drive truck or would an ATV/UTV be required?

Answer 4: FEUS is not familiar with the terrain about each structure. Access to structures from the ground may be restricted. It will be the responsibility of the contractor to obtain permission from property owners if structures are located within private property. FEUS may be able to provide contact information in such cases. Nevertheless, it is assumed all structures are accessible via 4WD truck. It would be prudent to have an ATV available. If an ATV will be used, the contractor is to follow all local and state laws concerning its operation. FEUS will NOT be held liable for trespass violations made by the contractor.

Question 5: Do all of the power poles have a unique identifier to reference all data to?

Answer 5: FEUS is not familiar enough with the facilities to provide an answer. The unique identifier for FEUS will be the GPS coordinate provided by the awarded contractor.
