Landfill Safety Rules

ALWAYS

Wear your seat belts.

Follow posted speed limits.

Wear high visibility vests and other safety equipment.

Follow directions from site personnel.

Maintain 15-ft spacing between your vehicle and others.

Stay next to your vehicle and remain alert to nearby activity.

Watch your footing. Ground surface may be uneven, slippery, and contain sharp objects that can puncture your shoes.

NEVER

Never salvage or scavenge.

Never allow children or pets outside of the vehicle.

Never assume that other drivers or equipment operators see you.

Never loiter after dumping.
