Waste Management will offer convenient service in your community for residents to properly dispose and recycle home-generated special materials - safely, easily, and responsibly. These items may include paints, household cleaners, compact fluorescent lamps (CFLs), automotive products, garden chemicals, batteries, electronics, and more, that can be conveniently picked up at your home by simply scheduling a collection.



At Your Door Special CollectionSM Service (continued)

Materials accepted through this program include:



Automotive Products

Antifreeze, batteries, brake fluid, motor oil and filters, fuels, and more.



Garden Chemicals Fertilizers, insect sprays, herbicides, pesticides, and weed killers.



Paint Products Paint, caulk, glue, stain, stripper, thinner, and wood preservative.



Household Cleaners Ammonia, heavy-duty cleaner, rust remover, tile/shower cleaner, upholstery cleaner, and more.



Electronics

Computer, monitor, keyboards, MP3 players, televisions, DVD/CD players, tape players, VCR, cell phones, desktop printers, fax machines, and microwaves.



Mercury containing items

Batteries, compact fluorescent lamps, fluorescent tubes, thermometers, and thermostats.



Sharps, needles, and lancets

Must be placed in a sealed, rigid, puncture resistant container.

Optional Bulk Item Collection Service

Starting August 1, 2019, Waste Management will collect bulk items for Farmington residents.

To schedule: Please call WM Customer Service at **505-327-6284** to schedule a pickup for either the **first** or **third Friday** of each month. The fee for a scheduled bulk pickup is **\$50**.

What is a bulk item? A bulk item is a household item too large to fit in a trash cart, such as a piece of furniture, household appliances (refrigerant removed if applicable), swamp coolers, hot water heaters, mattresses, and bundled or bagged green waste. To check the eligibility of your items for collection and to schedule your pickup, please call 505-327-6284.

Restrictions: For each appointment, you can dispose of up to three items. Tree trimmings, green waste, area rugs or carpet must be less than four feet in length and bundled, weighing no more than 75 pounds; Limit of 2-yards per collection (equal to about four trash carts). Construction debris, rocks, concrete, tires, and large pieces of metal (such as car parts) and hazardous waste are *not* considered bulk items.
