- Eight (8) tennis courts in the tennis complex with restrooms and the tennis pro shop.

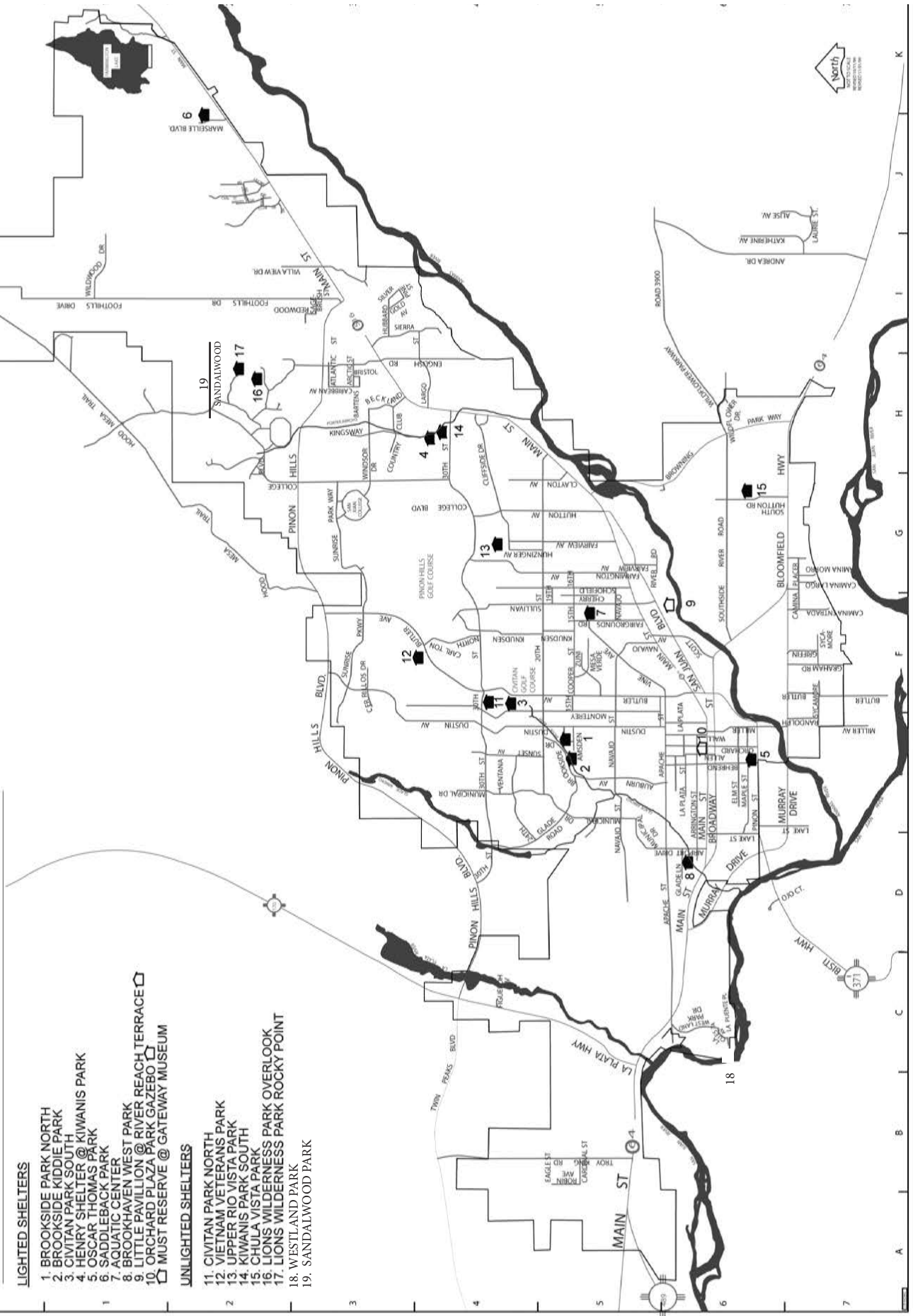

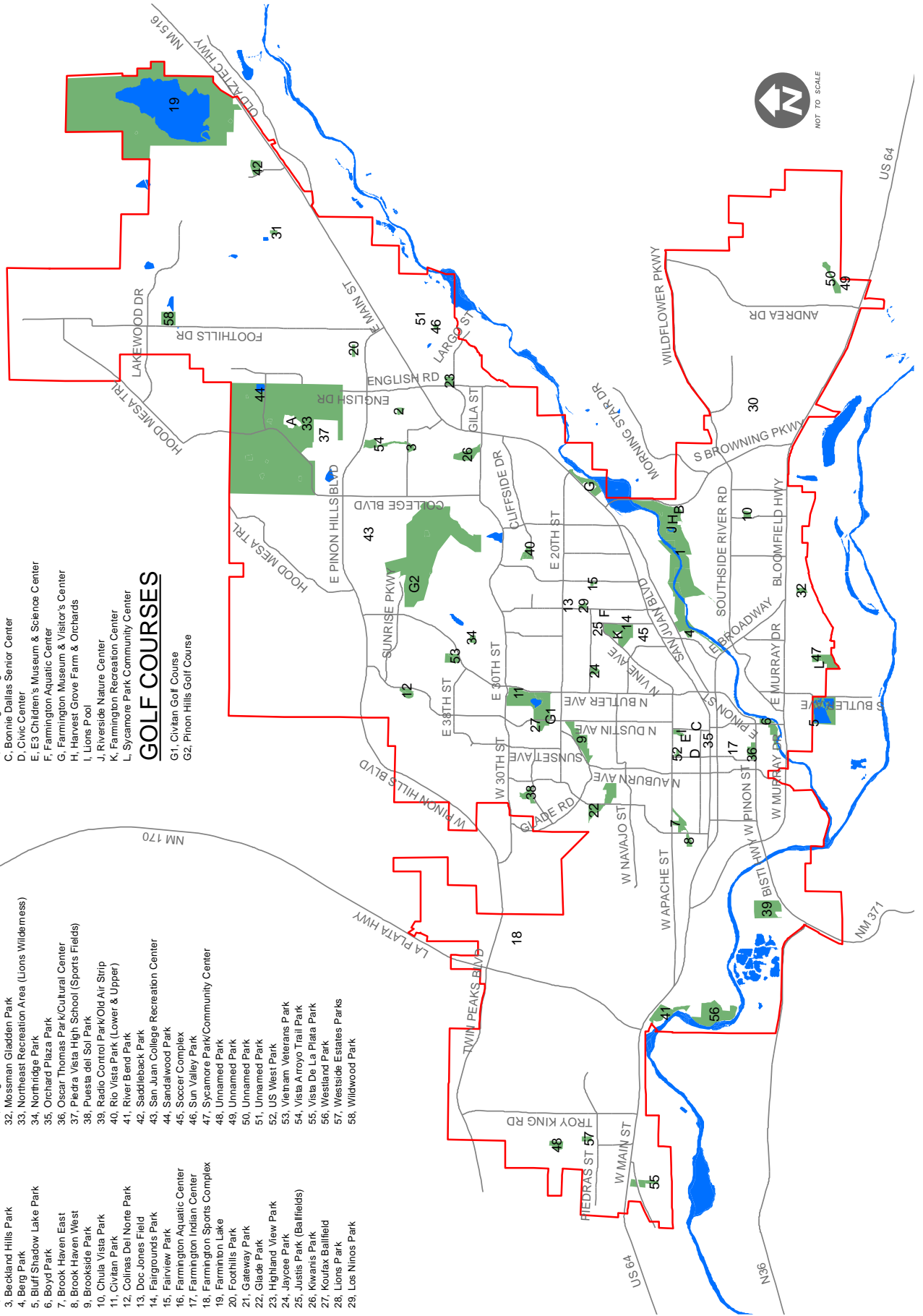
