



## **DOWNTOWN FARMINGTON REVITALIZATION – COMPLETE STREET PROJECT – March 26, 2020**

### **Project Update – Week 12:**

We are pleased to report the project is on schedule.\*

#### **Work Completed:**

- 100% of old services have been switched over to new supply lines
- Cut out old waterlines and completed storm drain installation on N. Orchard Ave.
- Cut and Cap old water line on Orchard Ave.
- 40% of Electrical and Irrigation conduit has been installed

#### **The Week Ahead – March 25 to April 1:**

- Electrical and irrigation conduit installation
- Place two 10' manholes one in Wall Ave. and one in Commercial Ave.
- Place LID #2 manhole in Commercial
- Remove 2 fire hydrants from old system
- Set manhole flat tops
- Gas line relocation at N. Orchard and alleyway

#### **A Look Beyond a Week:**

- Storm Drain and Low Impact Development (LID) subsurface storm water system installation
- Rough grading
- Curb and Gutter

#### **Work Hours:**

- Construction hours: Monday through Friday from 7am to 7pm. Noise level and vibration monitoring will be in effect. No night or weekend work is anticipated at this time.

#### **For Your Consideration:**

- Construction fencing has been moved to alleyways to accommodate new work zone for LID and Storm Drain Systems and other utility installation.
- Due to the increase in vehicles on Broadway, Farmington Police Department will be patrolling for speeding and pedestrian crosswalk violations.
- For those that are providing electricity for the temporary pedestrian lights and have entered into a power use agreement, please submit your vendor forms and your W-9. Instructions sent by email.
- Due to the Public Health Emergency Directive, all public meetings including the stakeholder meetings will be conducted online or by phone.
