Project Update – Week 14:

We are pleased to report the project is on schedule.*

Work Completed:

- 80% of Electrical and Irrigation conduit has been installed
- Placed 10' manholes in Commercial Ave. and Wall Ave.
- Cut and Cap of old 4" water line at Allen Ave.
- All storm drain manholes and pipe installed
- 25% of LID system on N. Orchard Ave. installed

The Week Ahead – April 8 to April 15:

- Electrical and irrigation conduit installation continues between Orchard Ave. and Allen Ave.
- Set manhole flat tops, and ring and covers to grade
- Orchard Ave. LID #3, piping and water quality manhole installation
- Drop inlet installation

A Look Beyond a Week:

- Continue electrical and irrigation conduit installation between Allen Ave. and Orchard Ave.
- Rough grading
- Curb and Gutter

Work Hours:

- Construction hours: Monday through Friday from 7am to 7pm. Noise level and vibration monitoring will be in effect. No night or weekend work is anticipated at this time.
