## RESOLUTION NO. 2021-1795

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON, NEW MEXICO ACCEPTING NEW MEXICO MAINSTREET CAPITAL OUTLAY FUND GRANT

WHEREAS, the City of Farmington recognizes that investment in the arts and historic buildings in downtown is vital to the economic growth of the downtown district; and

WHEREAS, Downtown Farmington: A MainStreet Project just completed the Complete Streets project, making downtown a destination for the community and visitor; and

WHEREAS, the partnership between San Juan County and the City of Farmington will create a "center for film" in downtown allowing visual arts education, screenings, and industry to thrive; and

WHEREAS, the Totah Theater will become an additional venue in downtown with state-of-the-art audio/visual equipment; and

WHEREAS, San Juan County has invested \$1,025,028.99 for renovation of the facility, of which the City of Farmington agreed to provide \$275,000 for fire suppression and roofing for the facility; and

WHEREAS, New Mexico MainStreet has agreed to award The City of Farmington in partnership with and for the benefit of Downtown Farmington: A MainStreet Project \$135,000 in Capital Outlay Funds for the Totah Theater Renovation Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Farmington agrees to participate and support this award for grant funding by acting as the fiscal agent to administer grant funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the governing body of the City of Farmington accepts the award of \$135,000 in grant funding to Downtown Farmington: A MainStreet Project's from the New Mexico MainStreet Capital Outlay Fund for the Totah Theater Renovation Project.
